<p>Regional MCI Plan</p>	<p>Rachel reminds the group that the regional MCI plan is due this quarter. Robin asks for any changes or updates that need to be made. Mike Magnar relays information from Kent Emerson: on page 12, "COVEOP Volume 4" should be changed to "COVEOP ESF#10, and Hazard Specific Annexes 1 and 5." "COVEOP Volume 8" should be changed to "COVEOP Hazard Specific Annexes 2 and 6." Robin asks everyone to send any updated contact info to Rachel by March 6th at 05:00pm. Plan is unanimously accepted with understanding that updated facility contact information is pending.</p>	<p>Motion by: Bubby Bish Seconded by: Brian Epperson Vote: MCI plan accepted pending updated contact info</p>
<p>New Business: Business from the floor</p>	<p>Bubby Bish talks about how many tactical medic classes are not being taught the same, and that State Police are looking at doing an awareness class. Mutual Aid Net is coming to the Virginia EOC that will list resources in Virginia for MCIs or other mass events, and will help track resources during such events. He also lets the group know that the National EMS Service is coming back to Virginia.</p> <p>Group discussion then turns to the 2015 Bike Race. Robin lets everyone know that the final courses are being announced today; plans are being developed to work through potential MCI concerns. Ken describes plans to run a full-scale exercise as a finish line explosion. Robin also reminds everyone that exit 74C will be shut down except for emergencies, so that will affect access to VCU (suggestion of using Leigh Street instead). Robin will continue to bring forth information about the race as it can be released.</p>
