Central Virginia Healthcare Coalition	Continuing to work through COVID and PPE issues; monitoring protests-states has been pretty uneventful but are monitoring upcoming events	
HCA	Finalizing CarePoint system and will be going live shortly with E-Bridge; agencies will be able to send reports via phone/visual/text/videos, and is HIPPA compliant; plans are to go live with Chesterfield in approx. 1 month, and will demonstrate to other agencies if interested	
<u>EMS Agencies</u>		
SVEC	Call volume has increased, with a notable increase in overdoses and attempted suicides	
Goochland	Nothing to report	
Hanover	Looking at quotes to double ballistics vests/helmets cache; will possibly administer vaccine in the spring and are ordering supplies now; call volume is back up with a notable increase in suicides and GSW's	
VDH	Working on catching up with adult and childhood vaccinations (for those who are behind due to COVID); aggressive flu campaign will be ramping up to get as many people vaccinated since it's difficult at times to tell the difference between flu and COVID; there are 5 different COVID vaccines being worked on (2 are genetically modified)	
<u>ODEMSA</u>	There is still a limited amount of PPE available and will continue to assist as many agencies as possible
