The exercise looked at some of the lessons learned from the 2016 Hurricane that affected both ODEMSA and the Eastern EMS regions. The tabletop exercise examined the different MCI plans and called for some standardization in terminology as well as looking at response guidelines across regions. Some thoughts from the exercise- a protocol for patient distribution between regions, some communication connections, and greater use of VA211. Additionally, Eastern regions uses primarily HEAR for communicating with hospitals while central uses cellular devices. Training/onboarding is needed on VHASS (the Virginia Status and Alerting System used by CVHC RHCC) for EMS agencies.</p> <p>The group asked for those involved in the recent active shooter drill between Chippenham and Chesterfield to give some points from the AAR next meeting.</p> <p>No business from the floor.</p>
