Meeting Called to Order	Dr. Yee called the meeting to order at 08:07am. Introductions were made, but we did not have a quorum, so today will be a work session. The September meeting minutes were reviewed, and there were no corrections.	
Reports: Bon Secours SRMC VCU HCA	Dr. Nelson – We're getting ready to go through chest pain accreditation and related visits over the next couple of months. Dr. Joseph – We have added two more cardiologists and our open heart program is going well. Dr. Dhindsa – We were reaccredited for chest pain and resuscitation. Ashley Hansen – JRMC received approval for chest pain accreditation cycle 5. Nancy Duncan – Chippenham and JW received their AMI accreditation. Chippenham also just did their first LVAD implant, and our advanced heart failure clinic is up and

<p>Old Business:</p>	<p>Mission Lifeline Report – John Dugan notes that the Q2 data is delayed due to a technological issue, so there is no report today. However, VHAC has a statewide call on the 16th at noon, and the state meeting is May 13, location TBD. Mission Lifeline EMS recognition will launch in January, and will expand for 2016 to include NSTEMI patients. Mission Lifeline: Stroke will be launched at Scientific Sessions.</p> <p>Dr. O’Brien notes that the STEMI showdown scheduled for Dec. 9 in the Farmville area is being rescheduled to January. Dr. Yee notes that it needs to be stressed to BLS providers that they cannot interpret ECGs.</p> <p>STEMI Quality Group – Rachel presents an online submission form that the quality group came up with as an alternative to the previously developed separate feedback form document. The group reviews, and notes that it may cause some issues on patient data safety because of discoverability, as well as still add an extra step for the hospital data personnel. The quality group will continue to discuss ways to retrieve this data safely, without imposing extra work on the hospitals.</p> <p>Regional Education Update – Dr. Yee notes that on a recent data review for the region, there has been little change after 12-lead classes were conducted in the area. This is likely still a documentation issue, and education is ongoing.</p>	



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<p>New Business:</p>	<p>Data use and sharing – Dr. Yee notes that the Board is going to work on a data use and sharing agreement for ODEMSA to determine how to look at agency-specific data.</p> <p>2016 Meeting Dates – Rachel explains that the meeting schedule is going to change a bit for 2016, and asks if there are any foreseeable problems with moving the STEMI meeting to the end of the first month of the quarter (January, April, July, October). The group notes that this is okay; the week will depend on what the Stroke Committee needs. Anne asks if the Stroke Committee meeting could be moved up since this meeting tends to not run 2 hours; Rachel will check with that committee.</p> <p>Business from the floor – Dr. Yee asks the group if we should be tracking NSTEMI/high risk ACS patients as a region. The group notes that it might be difficult to clearly define what patients will fall into that category, but it might be worthwhile. John notes that this data might be able to come out of Mission Lifeline.</p> <p>Dr. Yee also asks if there should be a cardiac arrest registry. John notes that Mission Lifeline is working on this as well. The group discusses additional options for this.</p>
