Reports: <u>Hospitals</u> Mcguire VA Medical Center CHS VCU CMH	They are changing their self-designation status from a limited hour stroke center to a primary stroke center. Laurie reported they are working on door in door out times. They have given 16 tPAs. DTN of 58 minutes. They had a recent DTN of 29 minutes.	



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Southside Community	Paula reported they are working on primary stroke center status.	
John Randolph Medical Center	They are in their window for recertification They have established an internal stroke alert system.	
Henrico Doctors Hospital	They have given more tPA this year than in years prior. They are looking into getting acute stroke ready certification for their freestandings but don't have the volume just yet as others have said for their freestandings. They have had 9 thrombectomies.	
VCU Health	They have had 5 pediatric stroke cases. The pediatric stroke protocol is going well.	
Bon Secours	They are working on a new transfer protocol that goes into effect May 15 th . This will allow rapid transfer to a comprehensive center. They are improving their door to needle time.	
CJW	They went through recertification as a system this year. Swift Creek was certified as the first acute stroke ready freestanding ER in the region.
