Reports: CHS - SRMC HCA – CMC, JW	Anne Fereday – SRMC has had three tPA patients that all were below 60 minutes for door to needle time. She stated that now all tPA patients will go to CT immediately. Donna Doherty – Donna said that their tPA patients have been 45 minutes or less in door to needle time and that they have begun to give tPA while the patient is in the CT scanner.

<p>Old Business:</p> <p>Post IV tPA Transfer Form</p> <p>Data on “Drips and Ships”</p>	<p>Stacie Stevens stated she brought the Odemsa Post IV tPA form to the state for approval and it was approved with some very minor changes. It has since been taken to the Office of EMS which received the recommendation to add the form to the state stroke plan. The form is a basic outline and the hospitals can customize it as they need. It was talked about getting the education on this form out to the EMS providers and updating the stroke triage plan with this new information.</p> <p>Adam Alford had been requested to get data on EMS providers doing “drip and ships”, if there had been any complications with the tPA drips during transport. He was unable to get the data due to most of the transport agencies that do these calls not being in the Odemsa region.
