NOTE: Patients with STEMI, Acute Stroke, Airway Obstruction, Uncontrolled Airway, Uncontrolled Bleeding, who are in Extremis, or with CPR in progress, should be taken immediately to the closest appropriate hospital, without regard to the hospital's diversion status but should still contact the Patient Distribution Center, so they are aware.

TRIAGE CATEGORIES

RED IMMEDIATE

- Includes STEMI, Acute Stroke or compromises to patient's Airway, Breathing, and/or Circulation.
- Can be helped by immediate intervention and transport.
- Requires medical attention within minutes for survival (up to 60).

YELLOW DELAYED

- Includes serious and potentially life-threatening injuries, but status not expected to deteriorate significantly over several hours.
- Transport can be delayed.

GREEN MINOR

- Relatively minor injuries.
- Status unlikely to deteriorate over days.
