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<p>New Business:</p> <p>ACS Trauma Triage</p>	<p>The ACS Trauma Triage has been updated, with an emphasis on the shock index; add burn component (peds and adults); do a side-by-side of the ACS and State triage plans *significant head impact, anti-coagulant use, and burns will require education; for burns, break out peds and adults, with and without trauma PI wants to create a sub-committee to work out the burn components (Beth Broering, Diana Jewett, Mike Watkins) State Meeting advised that Life Pak 15 is NOT peds compatible; is there a need for an adapter; how many peds patients are/have been defibrillated; are agencies out of compliance; look at peds arrest under 8yo; per Drs.
