Reports: <u>Hospitals</u> HCA	Dr. Dubovoy has joined the Stroke team as the newest neurologist; JRMC is changing their name to Tri-Cities Hospital and Tri-Cities FSED is changing to Prince George FSED; Blue Sky will be the service used for tele-specialists for tele-neuro; reverification survey will be conducted in 2023
