<p>Old Business:</p> <p>Training</p>	<p>Tidewater along with the State are still meeting and updating their MCI plan(s); the State did gather to review plan and reviewed the current triage tags (VDH showed a sample of the new tag to those in the office) and advised that the State wants to adopt SALT as the State approved triage method; MCI I and II is up for its 5-year review, but waiting for the regional councils to update their MCI plans so that the training material can be consistent with the respective plans</p>	
<p>New Business:</p> <p><u>Recent MCIs/Exercises</u></p>	<p>Chief Dennis Hale of Dinwiddie spoke on incident at Dinwiddie High School involving a chemistry experiment; the experiment was done once, but when attempted a second time, due to flammable vapors still in the air, it caused a “fire jetting”, injuring 4 students; one student was flown and the others taken by ground to VCU; Chief Hale advised that the floor plans utilized were up-to-date and the same one that the school has, and that when an incident occurs, the dept is assigned a liaison from the school; though the fire was put out quickly, there was some confusion and the injured students were mixed in with the general population when the school was being evacuated, but otherwise the incident went as well as could be expected; Chief Hale also stated that the incident made national, state, and local news, and assisted the School Board with their talking points</p>
