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<p>Old Business:</p> <p>Training</p> <p>MCI Plan</p>	<p>Bubby Bish advised reached out to Fire Chief in South Hill regarding MCI (explosion) and will join the next quarterly meeting to discuss; there was an MCI 1 and 2 training in Lunenburg this past weekend held at Central High School to show how chemical exposures/explosions are handled (worked with the National Guard); Craig Bride advised of in-facility active shooting training at Southern VA MC re: inmate overpowering guard, shooting him in front of nursing staff; training was successful and well received by staff</p> <p>Bubby will have MCI plan sent out for the next meeting</p>	
<p>New Business:</p> <p><u>Recent MCIs/Exercises</u></p>	<p>Chris Rockefeller advised Amelia Co called in April for a “post” MCI incident due to 3 patients injured and transported to Chip</p> <p>There was an Oct 8th school bus accident between Hanover and Henrico with 10 green peds patients</p> <p>Goochland had a 28 patient incident in July re: carbon monoxide generator in building; 8 were transported; worked with VCU comms to divide transports but there was some confusion after transport began as to where patients were going; there were no detriments to patient care; Hanover and Henrico assisted with the response and patients were transported to Forest, Short Pump EC, and Parham; worked with Robin Hillman to reconcile patients to employers (incident occurred at a medical office building); most were green and refusals were obtained; all birthdays and names are in narrative and that’s how pateints are tracked within their agency for MCI’s but transported patients had a conventional ePCR</p> <p>Chris Wholley advised there are several large events coming up in the next couple of months including the Richmond Marathon in 3 weeks and Lobby Day at the State Capitol is being held on the same day as the Presidential Inauguration</p>
