

## **EMS Training Scholarships**

The Center for Trauma and Critical Care Education in partnership with the VCU Injury Violence and Prevention Program have received two grants from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) of the US Department Health and Human Services (HHS). These grants fund several projects include providing tuition vouchers for EMS training Programs.

Qualifying individuals may receive a tuition voucher that can be applied to tuition for a VCU CTCCE sponsored EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic Course.

The voucher is only applied to tuition/registration fees - it cannot be used for books or other expenses.
